Summer Reading Packet

-first grade 2021/22-

We are so excited to have your child in our class next year! Please review the following skills/sheets during the summer break to keep skills sharp & prepare to begin first grade.

We plan to collect each student's packet during the first week of school.

Reading:

Please have your child read the pre-primer (list 1) words in isolation. Continue to read these words until mastery is reached. Once your child can read those words correctly, color in box number 1 in the "words" column and then move to reading the words in phrases. Once mastery is reached for pre-primer "phrases" 1, color in the box and move to list 2. Continue on until all lists are completed. If mastery is met for pre-primer and phrases, your child may move on to the primer word list in isolation.

Writing:

Each child needs to practice forming each letter of the alphabet (uppercase & lowercase) correctly. Also, please practice writing a sentence with appropriate capitalization and punctuation. Students should be using neat, legible handwriting and writing in the lines correctly.

Math:

Incoming first graders are expected to know how to count from 0-100 starting at any number. They should also know how to count backwards from 20 to 0. Students should be able to recognize number words from zero to twenty. Additionally, students should be able to compare, add, and subtract numbers between 0-10.



How to Prevent

the Summer Slide

"The Summer Slide" is a term educators use to describe when students forget skills over the summer holidays. To prevent this (and to prepare your child for next year), I recommend the following:

- Read books with your child! A visit to our library will keep your reading game on point. Talk about books with them.
- Play board games. This teaches your child to understand rules, take turns, count spaces, and practice numbers.
- Colour with crayons, markers, and coloured pencils.
 Colouring will practice pencil grip and fine motor skills.
- Encourage your child to write! Some students can write e-mails, letters, and grocery lists. Others are practicing writing their names. Talk about letters and their sounds.
- Computer or iPad time? No problem! Teach Your Monster to Read and TVO Kids are amazing, free, and educational!



- Play outside. Practice gross motor skills such as running, climbing, kicking, throwing, and catching.

- Encourage your child to build and experiment.




