

Grade Point Average Calculation & Class Rank

Class rank is determined by the GPA semester averages achieved in ALL classroom subjects. Calculations are carried to the fourth decimal place. Any courses taken outside the regular school curriculum must be disclosed at the beginning of each semester. AP and Dual Enrollment classes are weighted by 1 extra point towards GPA and Honors classes are weighted an extra .5 points. Grades, GPA and Class Rank are recorded on the student's transcript at the end of each semester.

Curriculum

All secondary students have 7 classes per day and spend 45 minutes in each class period.
Students have the option of taking additional AP courses not offered at Mount Dora Christian Academy through Ethos or Florida Virtual School.
